*La Cosecha 2011*, scheduled for November 16-19, 2011, marks the sixteenth anniversary of our annual conference, which brings together educators, parents, researchers and practitioners who support dual language programs. We offer the opportunity to share our experience and knowledge, and to network and “harvest” the best our multilingual communities have to offer. *La Cosecha 2011* will serve over 1,400 participants from throughout the Southwest and West, including California, Colorado, New Mexico, Oregon & Texas, as well as from other regions throughout the U.S. Our participants represent two-way immersion, developmental bilingual, and heritage language immersion programs.

We have begun planning for *La Cosecha 2011*, which will take place at the Albuquerque Convention Center in Albuquerque, NM on November 16-19, 2011. This year’s conference theme is **“Reforzando puentes entre idiomas: Strengthening bridges between our languages and cultures”**. University students pursuing careers in bilingual education have been an important part of past conferences, serving as volunteers, while being exposed to quality professional development. Dual Language Education of New Mexico is committed to continuing to support the student intern role at our conference by providing scholarships for student interns from the following universities, University of New Mexico, College of Santa Fe, New Mexico State, New Mexico Highlands, Eastern New Mexico, Western New Mexico and University of Texas at El Paso.

As a student intern you will receive full registration to the conference. In exchange for the scholarship, each Student Intern must commit to the following:

- A pre-conference orientation- **date/time/location to be determined at a later time.**
- A maximum of 10 full hours of volunteer work during the conference.
